SCCN is **Global Network of the Universities** and Higher Educational Institutes (HEIs) that localises **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and Carbon Neutrality**. The network encourages the youth in the universities to undertake projects in their own campus that relate to SDGs and Climate Change.



SCCN is part of Green TERRE Foundation, a company under Section 8, not-for profit company registered under the India's Companies Act, 2013, incorporated on 20th September 2022. TERRE is a global and local forum for action by youth and communities on the challenges faced by the planet's ecosystem, particularly climate change, biodiversity, health, and inequality. Activities like innovation, research and development for nature-based solutions by deploying the potential of youth and traditional knowledge of communities is the approach practiced by TERRE to address these challenges.

The project SCCN has now created a digital network of nearly 460+ Universities and HEIs (from 12 different countries) to promote the practical projects in the campus.

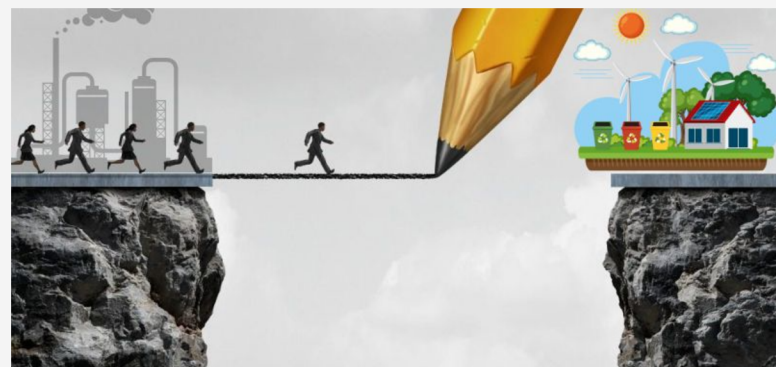
Apart from UNESCO, SCCN is supported by AICTE (Ministry of Education), EESL (Ministry of Power) in India and several national and International NGOs are the partners with SCCN. SCCN also works closely with SDSN, UNEP and UNFCCC.

The overall objective of the project is to **skill the students and faculty** in mainstreaming SDGs in the education system through practical work in the campus.

The key pressing point of SCCN is to emphasise hands-on and practical work than the class-room talks.

The network thus encourages priority initiatives, as decided by the youth from universities, in their respective campuses like Energy Efficiency & Renewable Energy, Water Conservation and Management, Waste Management, Sustainable Dietary Practices, Sustainable Transport and Afforestation.

Ideation, social innovation, nature solutions and research are integral part of the SCCN. The results of the practical work in the campus are shared globally across the universities through the digital cloud dashboard that SCCN has developed.
